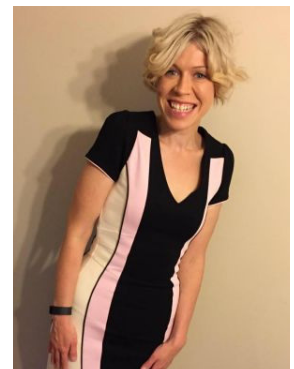

You will be inspired by strategies and ideas on how to really make IT count in your classroom.

Dean Pearman - Cultivating and Sustaining Innovation

How can schools develop the conditions for innovation? Dean will discuss and present ideas of how to develop and cultivate an innovative environment for change. Building teacher and student efficacy in the areas of innovation, listen to how he uses lean methodologies to scale up ideas and provide students with the necessary skills to learn and teachers with the environment to test, play and discover new ways to teach. Lauren Sayer- Achieving innovative digital change for success in the secondary years

Innovating with technology in a secondary school environment of high student achievement can be challenging: often with pressure on students to perform well and on teachers constrained by curriculum demands for external examinations. Lauren will lead a design discussion on how to achieve incremental change across schooling environments where implementing innovative change with technology can be difficult. You will experiment in small change exercises and prototype these into wider strategies for school wide change.

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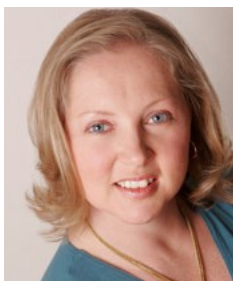
